FISHING RULES FOR MIDDLEBURY LAND TRUST PROPERTIES

1. Membership in Middlebury Land Trust, Inc., is a prerequisite to the issuance of a fishing permit.
2. A fishing permit is required for all persons age sixteen or older in order to fish on Land Trust properties. Children under age sixteen may fish when accompanied by a parent who has a valid permit. Permit holders should carry their permits with them when fishing.
3. The fishing season for Land Trust ponds extends from the third Saturday of April through October 31st.
4. The only Land Trust properties on which fishing is permitted are Lake Elise, located where Longmeadow Road joins Route 64, and Larkin Pond, located where Longmeadow Road joins South Street. Permits are valid for both properties.
5. All fishing will be catch-and-release only.
6. No boating is permitted.
7. No littering is permitted. Trash is to be deposited in the receptacles provided.
8. Violations of these rules should be reported to our Warden, Ben Lynn (860-417-8358), who regularly patrols the fishing areas.
9. Fishing permits are issued on a calendar year basis and expire on December 31st.
